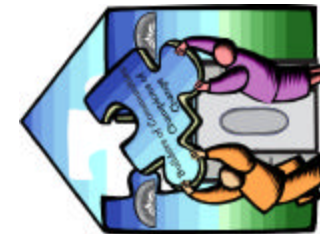
ABOUT THE COUNCIL
